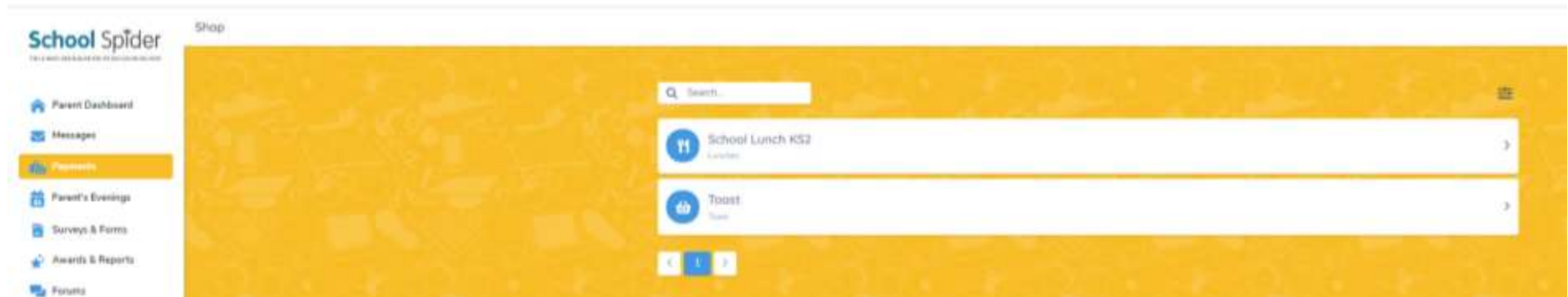
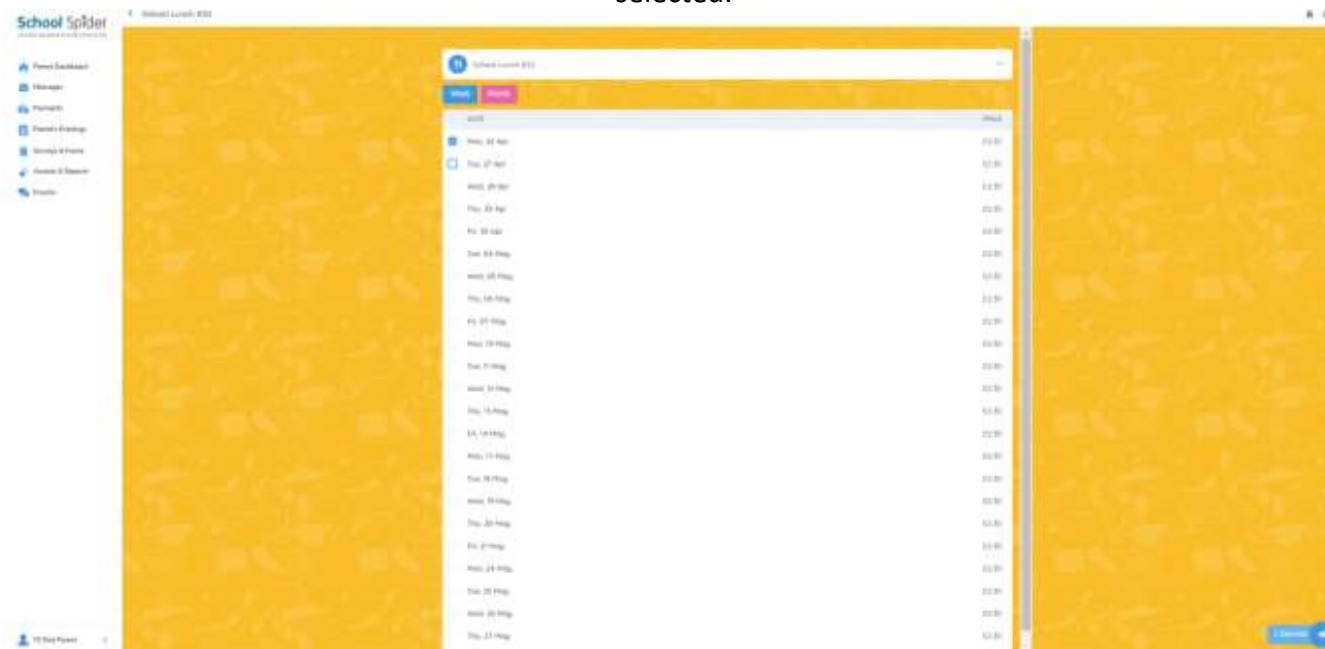


School Spider have now released their update for school lunches. All parents with children in KS1 & KS2 will be able to order their child's lunch in the payments section of the app.
