On Friday 8th September, Y5 & Y6 girls football trials will take place. Please ensure that your child has their PE kit in school.

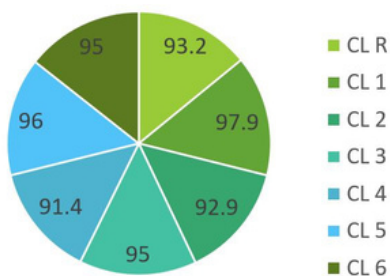

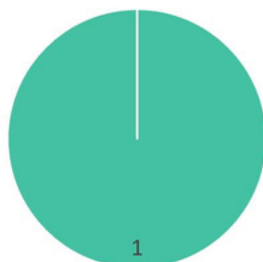
School re-opens for autumn term on Friday 1st September at 8.30am.
