"I am so small," said the mole. "Yes, but you make a huge difference."

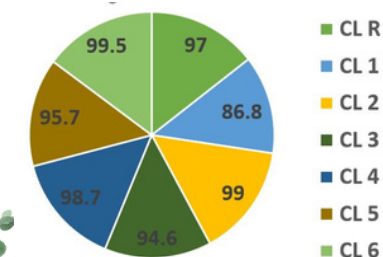

Enjoy the weekend!

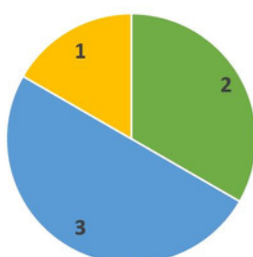

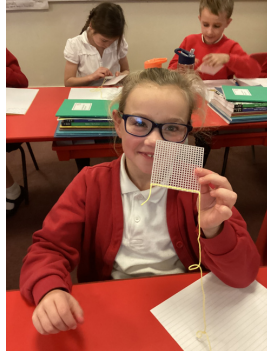

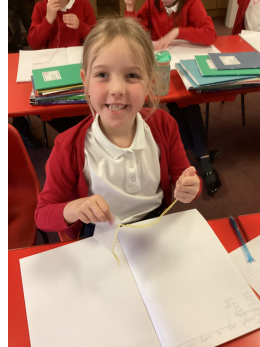

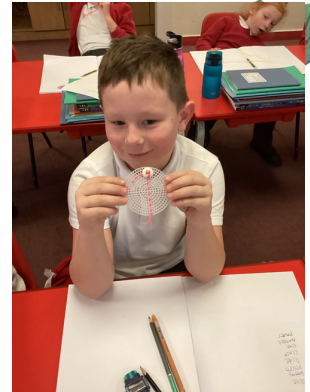
