



Sports Premium at BGL

The Sports Funding is an allocation of additional funding provided to schools to enhance the quality of Physical Education that the children receive. As a school, we are reporting on the amount of funding received and how this is being used.

At Brindle Gregson Lane we received £8000 plus an additional £5 per pupil.

This money is being used in a number of different ways to support the provision of improved quality of sports and PE for all pupils:

- A Specialist Sports teacher from Lostock Hall Academy delivering PE Lessons supported by the class teacher and therefore this elite coaching model provides continuous professional development opportunities to strengthen class teachers' skills, knowledge and understanding of the teaching of PE.
- To increase the opportunities for physical activity throughout the day by trialling a range of a whole school fitness programmes (e.g. 5 a day tv) which will then be purchased in the following academic year.
- To collaborate with South Ribble Sports Partnership and other Primary Schools to enable our pupils to take part in at least Level 2 competitions and Inclusion events with the local Authority/Local Area.
- Providing Sports Equipment to increase the range of activities for children at lunchtimes.

During the 2016/17 Academic Year, children from Brindle Gregson Lane Primary School took part in the following events:

- Indoor Athletics Competition
- Key Stage 1 and 2 Inclusion Events
- Central Venue Football League
- Boys and Girls Cricket Competition within the Local Authority
- Netball League
- Cross Country Competition

Our high participation in in Sporting Events has resulted in our school being awarded the Gold School Games Mark.

Remaining funds will be carried over to 2017/18 where planned provision includes the continued use of a sports coach who will join us Lostock Hall Academy for 1 day a week and will teach PE to all classes across the school throughout the year. Miss Rennox will also be running after school clubs throughout the year specifically linked to training our children for participation in Local Sports Competitions.

We also plan to use funds for the development of our playground.

Impact of the Funding:

- **Staff Questionnaires** clearly demonstrate an increased confidence and knowledge, skills and understanding of the teaching of PE.

100% of staff felt that the sessions with Miss Rennox were effective in improving their PE subject knowledge.

100% of staff either felt they could or already had put ideas into practise from these sessions.

100% could give examples of ideas/ways of delivering PE they'd learnt from observing/taking part in these sessions.

- **Pupil Questionnaires** clearly demonstrate an increase in the levels of enjoyment in PE sessions.

Children stated that they were now being taught a broader range of sports in PE lessons

Children spoke with confidence about what it means to be healthy and how we as a school are helping them to do this.

Children wanted more Sports equipment to be available at lunchtimes which we have looked into and provided.

- Increase in the range of sports being provided by school e.g. golf and tennis.
- Increased participation in and the range of after school clubs being provided by school.
